REVIEW OF WASTE BINS

The Executive recently approved a Bin Replacement programme across the borough. This aims to replace bins that are old, or too small for purpose, with new larger bins. It will also remove 'dog poo' bins and replace them with a larger regular bin, as there is now no longer a requirement for dog waste to be handled separately. As part of the planning work ClIrs will be working with residents to identify any bins which regularly overflow or could do with emptying more frequently, to ensure that these locations are mapped and prioritised.
