CEM/19/09 Apologies for absence

Apologies had been received and were accepted for Cllrs Stacey and Hartshorn. Cllr Chambers was noted absent without apologies.

CEM/19/10 Declarations of interest

No declarations of interest were made.

CEM/19/11 Public question time

No members of the public were present.

CEM/19/12 Exclusion of the press and public

There were no items to be dealt with after the exclusion of the press and public.

CEM/19/13 Proposal for a new tap in Lightwater cemetery

Following a request for a clean water tap to be installed in the cemetery, the Clerk provided quotes from two plumbing companies to install a self-closing tap. A self-closing tap would prevent water from being left running and hopefully stop any potential abuse of the water supply.

Quote 1 - £160.00 + VAT Quote 2 - £170.00 + VAT

It was resolved to install a new tap and approve quote 1 at £160.00+ VAT.

CEM/19/14 To consider a work plan/vision for each cemetery

Committee members had visited the cemeteries to make observations but the Clerk had been unable to locate electronic maps of each cemetery so committee members could use them to make meaningful notes. The only maps available (other than grave maps) were the large-scale maps in the noticeboards at each cemetery.

It was therefore agreed that CIIr Harris would be provided with copies of the maps held in the land registry documents and obtain a quote to produce digital maps from those documents.
