

Roadworks during COVID-19 restrictions

We have altered our roadworks programme and site safety practices to help keep workers and the public safe during COVID-19 restrictions. Essential and planned works are going ahead where it is safe to do so, to ensure the road network remains safe, open and operational.

We are working with all our contractors and others that work on the highway to make sure that government hygiene and strict social distancing rules are applied on site, to protect both staff and the public. For more information visit www.ourroads.today.

Information for residents and businesses

Resurfacing of the Maultway roundabout and all approaches will take place from 25th June to 2nd July. Work will be carried out over night between 8pm and 6am.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

Night works

Working overnight is necessary on traffic sensitive roads to reduce disruption during peak times. It also enables longer uninterrupted working before the closure has to be lifted for daytime traffic, and results in a shorter period of disruption.

Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs. We will also update [one.network](#) with the latest information.

Noise

There will be some noise, but we will try to carry out the bulk of the noisiest works before midnight.
