

Parking

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles, please find alternative locations to park, utilising drives and nearby roads as much as possible. We appreciate this is not always easy however it prevents us needing to return to the road to carry out additional repairs, or for us to have to tow your vehicles to nearby roads. If you have any special requirements, please speak to the team on site. You will still be able to park on your drive and access to drives will be maintained; but there may be a delay getting on and off through the works. Please allow extra time for journeys.
