RE: Draft Local Plan Engagement Strategy

Runnymede Borough Council has prepared a draft Local Plan Engagement Strategy for public consultation. The Engagement Strategy includes a demographic analysis of Runnymede's population. This data, together with data collected from previous consultations, has been used to identify groups which are often under-represented in planning policy consultations and seeks to identify means of engaging them in the Local Plan process.

Included in this document is a strategy identifying various consultation methods to be used at different stages of the Local Plan process. These methods have been designed to maximise the response rate to our consultations generally, but also to increase the proportional representation from the underrepresented groups identified. These are:

- Minority Ethnic Groups including the Gypsy and Traveller communities
- Disabled People
- Young people (Aged 34 years and under)/school children
- Older People (75 years and above)
- Low income groups

We are seeking views on this strategy, specifically in regards to the following:

- Whether our approach is comprehensive enough?
- Are there any additional methods of consultation which we should explore?
- Are there any bodies or representative groups that we can reach out to which we are currently unaware?
