CONSULTATION - EE LTD AND HUTCHISON 3G LTD

PROPOSED SHARED REPLACEMENT ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS APPARATUS AT CORBETT DRIVE ROUNDABOUT, CORBETT DRIVE, LIGHTWATER, SURREY, GU18 5LA (NGR: 491815, 161388) – REPLACING SITE 71648 "Red Road (B311)"

Mobile operators EE and 3 (H3G) currently have a radio base station located at the Red Road (B311), Lightwater, Surrey, GU18 5YT (NGR: 492085, 161249) which provides network coverage to the surrounding area. This site is being lost from the network for reasons beyond the operators' control. The loss of an established site from the network can result in a loss of communications and data services locally and wider disruption to the network if a replacement site capable of adequately replicating coverage within that specific area is not identified and integrated into the network at the earliest opportunity.

The operators are now seeking to secure a replacement site in your local area to prevent any loss of services once the apparatus at Red Road (B311) has been removed. Following a search of the area and consideration of various potential options, a suitable solution has been identified that can adequately replace the coverage being lost.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the proposed installation and provide you with an opportunity to comment or seek additional information prior to the works commencing.

<u>Proposed location</u>: Corbett Drive Roundabout, Corbett Drive, Lightwater, Surrey, GU18 5LA (NGR: 491815, 161388)

<u>Proposed development</u>: The proposed development consists of the replacement of existing 16.7m monopole installation and associated equipment with 1no 20m monopole supporting 9no antennas and 2no 300mm dishes, the installation of 1no wraparound cabinet, 5no equipment cabinets and ancillary development thereto. Please refer to drawings numbered 002, 100, 150, 200 & 250 (Rev A).

The selected design represents the best possible design solution, allowing a balance to be achieved between technical and environmental considerations. All efforts have been taken to keep the installation as small as possible, but this is bound by technical restraints.

The type of structure proposed is a slimline monopole that has been specifically designed to be deployed within suburban and urban areas and to blend, as far as possible with standard items of street furniture. It has a slim column, similar to a lamppost, with a slightly wide section at the top where the antenna are located. The equipment cabinets are similar in style to the type of utility (BT, Broadband, electric) boxes that are found at roadsides across the country.

We confirm that the installation has been designed to be fully compliant with the public health and safety guidelines established by the ICNIRP, the independent commission set up to provide scientific advice and guidance on the health and environmental effects of non-ionizing radiation to protect people and the environment. These guidelines have the support of UK Government and the formal backing of the World Health Organisation. They are in place to protect all members of the public, wherever they are in relation to a base station, 24 hours a day.




# SITE AREA PLAN
