

Item 5- Surrey Heath draft Local List consultation

Council have been invited to participate in the Surrey Heath draft Local List consultation. Please see details below:

A new draft Local List has been produced in partnership with Surrey County Council's Historic Environment Planning Team, as part of a government-funded project. A Local List comprises a list of buildings, structures or features which are recognised for their contribution to the local character, identity and distinctiveness of the borough. Once approved, this Local List will replace the Council's current List of Local Buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest.

The draft Local List will be available to view online at: <https://surreyheathplanningpolicy.inconsult.uk/SHBCLocalList> from 9am on Monday 29th January 2024. Comments can be made until 4pm on Friday 4th March 2024.

Following this it is anticipated that the Local List will be adopted by the Council in Spring 2024. Further information on the project and local listing is set out overleaf.

You are invited to review the draft Local List and make comments accordingly. Comments should focus on the assessment of an asset against the criteria and whether this is considered to be correct / incorrect. Any information regarding an asset which may alter its assessment is particularly welcomed. Please note that this is not an opportunity to submit assets that you consider should be locally listed that are not included in the draft Local List as that information was collected at an earlier consultation stage.
